### MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS.

**Club Rides.** There are organised 50-65 mile rides each Sunday starting at 8-30 or 9-00(Dec-Feb) from Cleveland Bridge & aiming to return around 1-1.30. There are usually three groups to cater for different abilities all heading for the same listed "coffee stop". Your ride will be more enjoyable if you are comfortable riding at an average speed of at least 14mph. There is also an all day ride on Tuesdays that depart at the same times but from varying start points.

**Chain Gang training ride** This is a training ride round a 42 mile route starting & finishing outside Cadence Bike shop (Chelsea Road) with a choice of 16-18mpd group leaving at 9.15 then a faster group setting off in pursuit at 9.30. After the ride, get together at The Chelsea Café, opposite Cadence.

**Club Confined Races.** We organise a series of evening time trials including a team event between April - August. These are less formal events and are perfect to try time trialling for the first time.

**Open CTT Races.** You will also be able to enter the many open time trials held in the area with distances varying from 10 to 100 miles. The Bath CC organises an open 25-mile race, a 10-mile and a Hilly 24.

*As you will appreciate these events involve a great deal of work for the club organisers, so any help you can offer to support the club on the day of the race will be very welcome. With this in mind, it would be appreciated if you would indicate below whether you would be willing to be contacted if help is ever needed on a particular occasion.*

**Road Racing.** Join the British Cycling (BC) to be able to enter Road Racing events. Contact our Road Racing Secretary Matt Hargreaves [RoadRace@bathcc.net](mailto:RoadRace@bathcc.net).

**Juniors.** We welcome Juniors (under 18) and Juveniles (under 16) to the Club. But, please note; a condition of membership for those under 18 years is that if they wish to compete in any time trial or road race, including club time trials, they must be accompanied to and from the event by a parent or legally recognised guardian or a responsible relative over the age of 18 who has been nominated by the parent or guardian, who should also countersign this membership application form. These conditions are dictated by the requirements of The Child Protection Act.

**Insurance.** Accidents in the Club have been infrequent considering the high mileage covered by Club members, but accidents do happen. Members are strongly advised to take out some cover in case of an accident. This can be obtained privately, or, like most riders, by taking out silver or gold membership of British Cycling (BC) or joining the Cyclists' Touring Club (CTC) who both provide legal assistance with any claims.
