COURSE – U32B



Start in the layby on the SE side of the A361 between the Pylon and Blatchbridge roundabouts. Head SW for about 2 miles to the Blatchbridge roundabout, take 1st exit on the B3092 signposted Maiden Bradley. Continue to Maiden Bradley. **Take care through village with parked cars and traffic calming.** Follow the B3092 through Maiden Bradley to pass under the A303 to Mere. **Ride through Mere with extra care due to parked cars,** then leave Mere on the B3095 passing under the A303 again, and up the 1 in 7 hill and then descend through **two sharp bends** to Kingston Deverill. Continue through Monkton Deverill, Brixton Deverill and Hill Deverill to Longbridge Deverill, **take care when going through these villages due to narrow road.** Left onto A350 and after about 100 yards take the next left onto the minor road to Maiden Bradley. Continue on this road and finish shortly before the entering Maiden Bradley, opposite the layby, just before the 2nd turning to Horningsham.

HEADQUARTERS – Frome Town Football Club

AlderSmith Stadium, Berkley Road, Frome, Somerset, BA11 2EH

Approaching Frome from the North, take the B3090. Where road branches take left toward Berkley. After Cricket ground on your left, at traffic lights take left onto Berkley Road. FTFC is on your right.

From the South proceed through the centre of Frome, and head north on the B3090. Take Berkley Road to the right soon after crossing the river. Pass through the traffic lights, and FTFC is on the right hand side.

We expect to have enough parking for everyone in the ground, but please park carefully. If the ground fills, park in St.Johns Road (immediately E of FTFC).

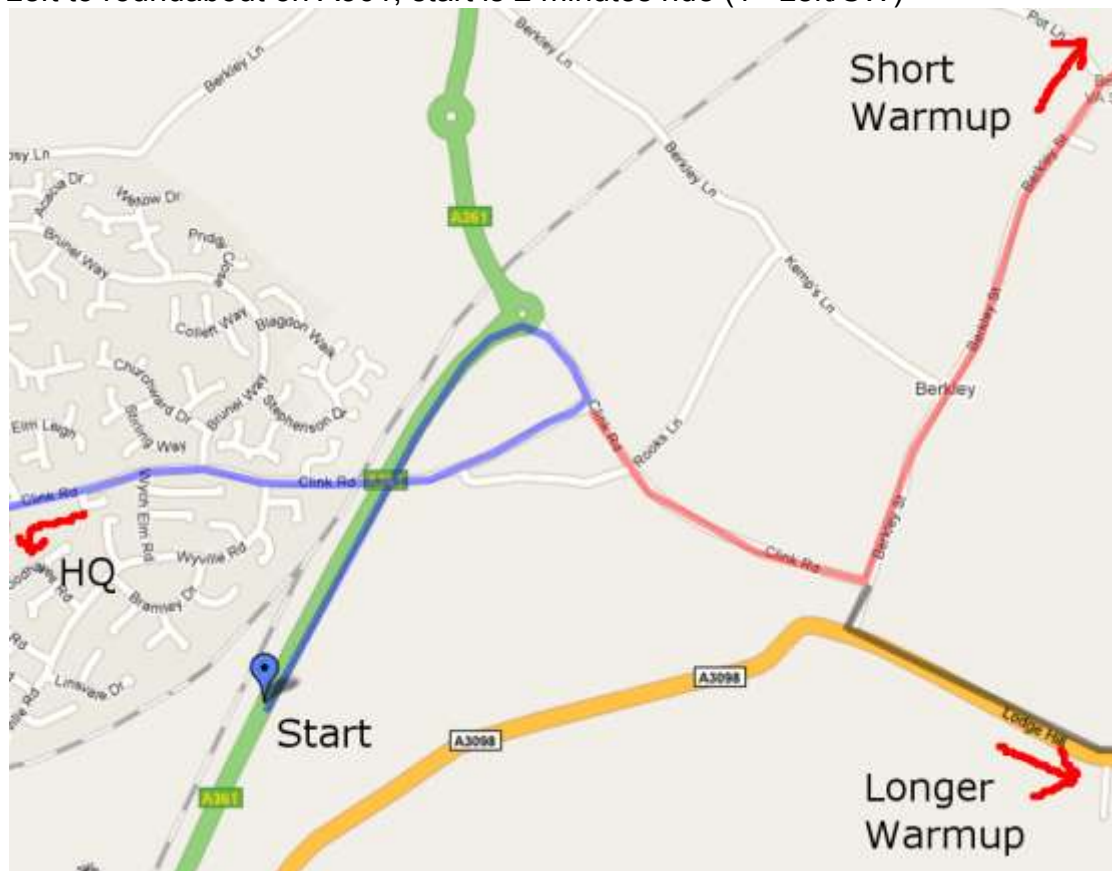
HQ Open from 7:30am (planned – if my eyes are open!)

WARMUP

At the T junction at the end of Berkley/Clink Road two options:

- Right to T and Left signposted Berkley. Good road for warm up, 2 miles and quiet
- Right to T, Right to T, Left onto A3098 signposted Chapmanslade– more extensive warm-up – but remember you way back again!

Left to roundabout on A361, start is 2 minutes ride (1st Left/SW)



HQ is off to left

Blue line leads to Start – only join the A361 to go direct to start – no U turns.

Red line leads to short (2 mile) warm up

Black line leads to longer warm up

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Approximately 2 miles to the start, allow 10 minutes. Turn right out of the HQ. Follow Berkley Road, it turns into Clink Road. Left at T junction. 1st Left at Pylon Roundabout. Start layby in 0.5 miles.
2. Only proceed SW on the A361 from the Pylon Roundabout when approaching to start.
3. No U turns on the A361 to the start, this will result in disqualification.
4. Take great care in Maiden Bradley Village, due to traffic calming and parked cars.
5. Take great care riding through Mere. Expect some parked cars and observe normal safety precautions. Traffic should be reasonably light at the time of the event but cannot be guaranteed.
6. Keep left on the through road in Mere
7. There are a pair of tight bends descending into Kingston Deverill after a very fast descent, take great care.
8. You will pass through villages via a narrow road after this descent, take care.
9. Riders are reminded of Regulation 21. Paced and Company Riding
“Competitors must ride entirely alone and unassisted and not ride in the company or take shelter (commonly known as drafting) from another rider or vehicles.”
10. Riders are reminded of Regulation 22a. Use of Motor Vehicles
“A competitor shall not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle or its occupants, ...”
11. Riders are requested to cycle back to the HQ if at all possible; tops can be left at the start, and will be transported to the finish for you to ride back in. Tops can be collected from Maiden Bradley Village Hall, on your right after you finish.
12. Only where strictly required, should helpers travel to Maiden Bradley. Strictly no support cars in the road to the left which leads to the finish, turn right at the cross roads (Westward) to park. The finish is only a few minutes walk away.
13. At the finish do not stop by the time keeper, continue on the minor road to the cross roads with the B3092. Take care at this crossroads, you cross the course. Take right, and retrace the course past the start and back to the HQ.

Both body & arm numbers will be used for this event. Please ensure that the body number is clearly visible from behind and fixed in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arm facing forwards.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY:

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a **HARD SHELL HELMET** that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

In accordance with Regulation 15 **ALL JUNIOR** competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
